Criteria

The applicant must possess the following qualities to be considered a candidate for the Ron Hemmerling Memorial Scholarship.

- An athlete currently registered with BCLA as a box or field lacrosse player.
- A person who displays a strong love and dedication to the sport of lacrosse, is a positive teammate and selfless player on and off the floor. Treats all team personnel with respect (players, coaches, officials etc.)
- The applicant must provide proof of registration at a post-secondary educational institution before any funds will be disbursed. This includes any University, College, Trade School, or Performing Arts school in Canada.
- Committee will consider a mix of factors such as financial need, merit, and altruistic qualities such as community involvement, volunteerism, and leadership.

Please include the following with your Application Form:

- An essay of approximately 500 words describing why you think you should be considered for this scholarship.
- A copy of your most recent school transcript.
- A letter from your lacrosse coach or manager outlining your suitability for a scholarship.
- Any other information that you feel may be helpful in your effort to receive this scholarship.
- **Photo** to be used on the BCLA website and social media when announcing winners of scholarships.
