Coaches Meeting: (Time and Location TBA)

In the coaches meeting, please submit a copy of your **Team Verification Form**. In addition, please bring your completed **Fair Play Award Athlete Nomination Form**. The forms are attached to this email.

At least 30 minutes before each game, a coach or manager must complete and verify the game sheet in the tournament office

Any call-up player being used in the tournament has to have played the required three (3) qualifying games, proof of playing will be confirmed with *original **official score sheets, either the pink or the yellow copy*** (scans, photos, and/or photocopies will not be accepted).

****Please note the schedule is by game time with the field info across the top of the schedule****

TEAM VOLUNTEERS

Each participating team must provide the following volunteers per round robin game: **one team to provide 1 timekeeper and one team to provide 1 scorekeeper**. *Neutral score and timekeepers will be provided for crossover and medal games.*

Each team should also appoint a responsible person for selecting game MVPs for round robin games. That person will select 3 players from the opposing team for each game. Players are only eligible for one award during the round robin portion of the tournament. *Neutral bench officials will select the medal game MVPs.*

Please have a team official report to the tournament office located in the tournament office at the Telosky Field thirty minutes prior to game time to pick up your score sheet and MVP awards sheet. Both will be returned to the tournament office by the officials following the game.

GAME FORMAT

All Round Robin Games:

Games are four 10 min quarters,

- 2 minute Intermission
- No Time Outs
- No Stick Checks

Red and Blue Cross Overs Sunday:

Games are four 12 min quarters,

- 2 minute Intermission
- No Time Outs
- No Stick Checks

Medal Games Sunday:

Games are four 12 min quarters,

- Stop Time Last 30 seconds 1st, 2nd and 3rd Quarter
- Stop Time Last 2 Minutes 4th Quarter if 5 goals or less
- One Time Outs per Half
- No Stick Checks

No Overtime in Round Robin Games

Division Format:

The Field Directive tie-breaker rules will apply to teams tied with points.

The **Blue Division** will play a round robin with 2 pools, with cross over games for semi finals. First and Second place will play for Gold and third and fourth will play for Bronze.

The **Red Division** will play a round robin with 2 pools, with cross over games for semi finals. Winners of the cross over semi-final games will play for gold and the two defeated teams will play for Bronze.

The **White Division** will play round robin. First and Second place will play for Gold and third and fourth will play for Bronze.

OVERTIME RULES (for crossover and medal games only)

In the event of the score being tied at the end of regulation playing time, play shall be continued, after a 2-minute intermission, with sudden victory overtime. In sudden victory overtime teams shall play periods of 4-minutes each until a goal is scored, thus deciding a winner. The game ends upon the scoring of the first goal. There will be a 2-minute intermission between sudden victory periods.

No time-outs shall be allowed in a sudden victory overtime period.

TIE BREAKER RULE - FULL ROUND ROBIN

In the event of a tie in points, final standings shall be determined by the tie breaker-rule in the Provincial Directive.

SHOULDER PADS & MOUTHGUARDS

Approved shoulder pads and mouthguards are **MANDATORY** for all players participating in the tournament. This requirement will be strictly enforced.

SUSPENSION GUIDELINES

Please read the attached Field Directorate Suspension. Any questions regarding the suspension guidelines should be referred to the Referee In Chief (RIC).

VENUE

Players and team officials are requested to abide by venue rules at Telosky Stadium. Players should be supervised in and around the facility **NO LACROSSE BALLS** are to be thrown or tossed against walls in or around Thomas Haney Secondary. Balls and sticks will be confiscated by facility staff if this rule is violated.

Games will be played on three fields:

1. Telosky 1 (Polygon)
2. Telosky 2 (Morningstar) located at 23000 116 Ave
3. Arthur Peak/Golden Ears located at 23125 116 Ave.

Please refer to the attached map for field locations.

Please have teams only warm up in the areas designated on the maps. If coaches could please avoid warming up on the sidelines when there is a game running, as warm up balls and players end up on the field of play.

TOURNAMENT AMENITIES

On-site amenities will include a concession and BCLA provincial souvenir apparel provided by Silver Ridge Promotions Saturday and Sunday. There will be a food truck onsite during the weekend games at Telosky Stadium.
