Step 1: Login and Select Official Registration


After creating a registration account or signing in you will see the following dashboard Once here select the “Official Registration” tab to continue the registration.



Select 2026 Box Lacrosse

Choose the member you are registering. If you are already in RAMP with the email you are using, you will just select that name and then verify the information is correct. If you have never registered with RAMP, then you will need to “add new member”.

The last drop down is Choose Officiating Level - just click official



Part 2: Registering To a Clinic


Step 1: Select Clinic Registration

Select via the search controls listed options which official clinic you would like to register for.




Step 3: Review the Clinic Details and Select Package(s) to Register In
